

REVELATION #31: GETTING READY FOR THE GRAND FINALE

Revelation 15:1-8 (ESV)

- The “bowl” means that God’s wrath will be poured out quickly and completely.

Note: Smoke is a symbol of the glory and power of God. It is sometimes call ‘the Shekinah’.
(Exodus 40:33-35; 2 Chronicles 7:1-4; Isaiah 6:4; Ezekiel 10:4)

- Who are these people singing praises in heaven? They are the tribulational saints.
- The image of glass mingled with fire symbolizes the fiery trials these tribulational saints endured. And, it also symbolizes the fiery judgment of God that is about to fall.
- God takes it personally when His people come under attack.

A few points to consider about the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb:

The song of Moses is sung at the Red Sea. The song of the Lamb is sung at the crystal sea.

The song of Moses is a song of triumph over the Pharaoh. The song of the Lamb is a song of triumph over the Antichrist.

The song of Moses is the first song in the Bible. The song of the Lamb is the last song in the Bible.
